1. The Consent to Establish is granted for a period upto commissioning of project or up to 5 year whichever is earlier.
2. The capital investment of the project is Rs.78.9 Cr. (As per undertaking submitted by pp).
3. The Consent to Establish is valid for Construction of Residential Building project named as M/S. Raj Homes ,plot bearing S. no 127, H. no. 9 to 16 & 19, Village- Mahajanwadi, Taluka & District Thane., on Total Plot Area of 6390 SqMtrs for Total construction BUA of 33908.75 SqMtrs including utilities and services

9. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/permission from any other Government agencies.
10. PP shall provide STP so as to achieve the treated domestic effluent standard for the parameter BOD-10 mg/lit.
11. The treated effluent shall be 60% recycled for secondary purposes such as toilet flushing, air conditioning, cooling tower make up, firefighting etc. and remaining shall be utilized on land for gardening.
12. PP shall install online monitoring system for pH, BOD, TSS and flow at the outlet of STP with connectivity to MPCB Server.
13. PP shall install organic waste digester along with composting facility/biodigester (biogas) with composting facility for the treatment of wet garbage.
14. Project Proponent shall take adequate measures to control noise and dust emissions during construction phase

15. Project Proponent shall make provision of charging port for Electric vehicles in at least 10% total available parking area

### SCHEDULE-I

#### Terms & conditions for compliance of Water Pollution Control:

- 1) A] As per your application, you have proposed to provide MBBR based Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) of combined capacity 240 CMD for treatment of domestic effluent of 219 CMD.  
B] The Applicant shall operate the sewage treatment plant (STP) to treat the sewage so as to achieve the following standards prescribed by the Board or under EP Act, 1986 and Rules made there under from time to time, whichever is stringent.

- C] The treated domestic effluent shall be 60% recycled for secondary purposes such as toilet flushing, air conditioning, cooling tower make up, firefighting etc. and remaining shall be utilized on land for gardening and connected to the sewerage system provided by local body.
- 2) The Board reserves its rights to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of waterworks for the purification thereof & the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions. The Applicant shall obtain prior consent of the Board to take steps to establish the unit or establish any treatment and disposal system or and extension or addition thereto.
- 3) The industry shall ensure replacement of pollution control system or its parts after expiry of its expected life as defined by manufacturer so as to ensure the compliance of standards and safety of the operation thereof.
- 4) The Applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and as amended, and other provisions as contained in the said act.

- The Applicant shall obtain necessary prior permission for providing additional control equipment with necessary specifications and operation thereof or alteration or replacement well before its life come to an end or erection of new pollution control equipment.

- The Board reserves its rights to vary all or any of the condition in the consent, if due to any technological improvement or otherwise such variation (including the change of any control equipment, other in whole or in part is necessary).

- Conditions for utilities like Kitchen, Eating Places, Canteens:-**

- The kitchen shall be provided with exhaust system chimney with oil catcher connected to chimney through ducting.
- The toilet shall be provided with exhaust system connected to chimney through ducting.
- The air conditioner shall be vibration proof and the noise shall not exceed 68 dB(A).
- The exhaust hot air from A.C. shall be attached to Chimney at least 5 mtrs. higher than the nearest tallest building through ducting and shall discharge into open air in such a way that no nuisance is caused to neighbors.



#### Conditions during construction phase

|   |  |

| A | During construction phase, applicant shall provide temporary sewage and MSW treatment and disposal facility for the staff and worker quarters.   |
| B | During construction phase, the ambient air and noise quality shall be maintained and should be closely monitored through MoEF approved laboratory.   |
| C | Noise should be controlled to ensure that it does not exceed the prescribed standards. During night time the noise levels measured at the boundary of the building shall be restricted to the permissible levels to comply with the prevalent regulations. |

#### General Conditions:

- 1 The applicant shall provide facility for collection of samples of sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
- 2 The firm shall strictly comply with the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and Environmental Protection Act 1986 and Solid Waste Management Rule 2016, Noise (Pollution and Control) Rules, 2000 and E-Waste (Management & Handling Rule 2011.
- 3 Drainage system shall be provided for collection of sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No sewage shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the terminal manholes. No sewage shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
- 4 Vehicles hired for bringing construction material to the site should be in good condition and should conform to applicable air and noise emission standards and should be operated only during non-peak hours.
- 5 Conditions for D.G. Set
  - a) Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by providing an acoustic enclosure or by treating the room acoustically.
  - b) Industry should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
  - c) Industry should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside industrial premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper siting and control measures.
  - d) Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.

- e) A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.
- f) D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
- g) The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.
- h) The applicant shall comply with the notification of MoEFCC, India on Environment (Protection) second Amendment Rules vide GSR 371(E) dated 17.05.2002 and its amendments regarding noise limit for generator sets run with diesel.
- 6 Solid Waste - The applicant shall provide onsite municipal solid waste processing system & shall comply with Solid Waste Management Rule 2016 & E-Waste (M & H) Rule 2011.
- 7 Affidavit undertaking in respect of no change in the status of consent conditions and compliance of the consent conditions the draft can be downloaded from the official web site of the MPCB.
- 8 Applicant shall submit official e-mail address and any change will be duly informed to the MPCB.
- 9 The treated sewage shall be disinfected using suitable disinfection method.
- 10 The firm shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the environment statement report for the financial year ending 31st march in the prescribed Form-V as per the provision of rule 14 of the Environmental (Protection) Second Amended rule 1992.
- 11 The applicant shall obtain Consent to Operate from Maharashtra Pollution Control Board before commissioning of the project.
